Hunter Valley Rail Corridor





Aurizon has been servicing coal producers in the Hunter Valley region since 2005. Over the ensuing years Aurizon has invested more than \$500 million in the region and now provides rail haulage for around one quarter of the Hunter Valley coal export market.

Aurizon continues to invest in rail infrastructure and rollingstock in the region. With offices in Newcastle and a new provisioning and maintenance facility at Hexham, near the Port of Newcastle, Aurizon is committed to supporting growth in the Hunter Valley.

The \$180 million Hexham Train Support Facility (TSF) provides for the relocation of fuelling, provisioning and inspection activities previously located at Kooragang Island and Carrington. Aurizon has train crew depots at Mayfield, Duralie and Quirindi.

Major Aurizon Customers in the Hunter Valley region include BHP Billiton, Peabody Energy, Whitehaven and Yancoal.

Aurizon secured a long-term contract extension with BHP Billiton for its Mt Arthur coal

mine to June 2028 with increased haulage volumes from 18 mtpa to a maximum of 26 mtpa. In March 2015, we commenced railing from Whitehaven's Maules Creek mine under a 12-year contract.

Since 2011, Aurizon has provided grants to over 200 charities and community groups around Australia as part of our Community Giving Fund program. The program supports charities working in the areas of Health and Wellbeing,
