

Newlands coal rail corridor



The Newlands Coal Rail System is one of four systems in Aurizon’s Central Queensland Coal Network (CQCN). It is located at the northern end of the Bowen Basin in North Queensland.

In 2012 Newlands was linked to Aurizon’s Goonyella Coal Rail System, providing CQCN customers with additional flexibility to access the Port of Abbot Point. The project included construction of the 69 kilometre ‘Northern Missing Link’, which connects the two rail systems, along with substantial upgrades to existing Newlands rail infrastructure.












Major Aurizon customers in Newlands include Glencore, Jellinbah Resources and QCoal.
