## Our land access protocol commitments

#### **Communication and consultation**

We will be respectful and courteous, with a 'no surprises' approach. Where requested, we will advise the landholder before entering their property, explain the activities we will be undertaking, and provide regular progress updates. We will investigate and address in a timely manner any matters raised by the landholder.



#### Biosecurity and declared pest plant management

We will implement measures where necessary to manage the potential spread of declared pests and pathogens in accordance with our legislative obligations.



### Gates, grids and fences

We will leave gates, grids and fences as found unless otherwise agreed with the landholder and will consult with the landholder before making any changes. If we cause any damage, we will report it to the landholder and repair it.



# Land Access Protocol



### Respect for people, livestock, land and property infrastructure

We will avoid disturbing people, livestock, land and property infrastructure whenever possible. If we cause an adverse impact, we will report it to the landholder and replace or repair the damage.



#### Use of access points, roads and tracks

We will agree with the landholder the use of access points, roads and tracks on their property and will maintain them in good condition while we are using them. We will operate our vehicles safely to keep people and livestock safe, avoid damage, and minimise noise and dust.



#### Vegetation removal and erosion control

We will implement measures to manage impacts to soil integrity, trees and other vegetation caused by our activities in accordance with any legislative approvals and good industry practice.



#### No firearms, animals or alcohol

We will not take firearms, animals or alcohol onto private land.



#### **Fire management**

We will implement appropriate fire control measures for relevant activities. We will only allow smoking on private land with landholder consent and in designated areas agreed by the landholder.



#### Managing potential contaminants

We will store, handle, transport and dispose of any potential contaminants in accordance with applicable regulations, Aurizon policies and Australian Standards.

#### Waste management

We will keep our work site clean and will remove all waste from private land when we finish work.



#### Landholder confidentiality

We respect the privacy of landholders and will treat with confidence all discussions with landholders and the information they provide. We will comply with privacy related obligations in relevant legislation.
